- 10. Malpractice: Convener of the committee shall convey a meeting of the members and discuss the complaint received from the principal
- 11. The committee may call the candidate to seek an explanation and hear from him/her. Explanation shall be taken in writing.
- 12. The committee members shall make necessary enquires from exam supervisors and other related witnesses.
- 13. After hearing all the above persons, they shall report their findings in writing, along with recommended punitive action (if any malpractice was detected) to the principal according to the college guidelines/norms.
- 14. Be open to receive grievances regarding examinations and resolve them as early as possible.
