REACT is Kumaraguru's social innovation programme where you join a team, spend your college years here solving one real problem properly, and come out the other side having actually built something, alongside your regular coursework. A REACT team picks a real problem, something a farmer deals with, a patient waits through, a family pays too much for, and spends the next few years building an actual answer to it. Beyond presentations and pitches, that answer becomes a registered company, with your name on the paperwork, before you've even graduated.

You bring the perspective of your own discipline, engineering, commerce, economics or the business school. Sitting across from you is someone who studied something entirely different, and between the two of you, the problem stops being theoretical. Most people find, as they move through their journey, that the first year is the right time to start. You're finding it now, while it still counts.

The next few years look like this.

Fourteen days inside a real community, close enough to understand the problem through someone's daily life. Research strong enough to publish. A prototype handed to people who owe you nothing and will tell you exactly what can be made better. A patent with your name on it. A pitch, in a real room, to people deciding with real money whether what you built deserves to exist.

All of this comes together to create what matters most: a company still standing on its own, still earning, long after the classroom part of your life is over.
